The Washington Capitals Fan Club, a member of the National Hockey League Booster Clubs, was established in 1975 to promote and support the activities of the Washington Capitals and the NHL. We encourage attendance and participation at Washington Capitals home and away games, and other scheduled activities for the betterment of professional ice hockey and the local community.

Our activities include group trips to Capitals away games, meetings, hospitality with visiting NHL booster clubs, and involvement with charitable organizations in the community supported by the Washington Capitals. We also conduct off-season events such as attending Washington Nationals games.

We welcome new members to share in the excitement of rooting for the 2019-2020 Washington Capitals. Your annual membership includes:

- A monthly general membership meeting during the season with hockey-related guests. Speakers during the 2018-2019 season included Joe Beninati, Craig Laughlin, Rob Carlin (NBCSW), Alan May (NBCSW and Capitals Alumni), Courtney Laughlin, and Ian Oland (RMNB).
- A newsletter with details on upcoming Fan Club activities including road trips, charity events, and Capitals news;
- An annual gift, a ball-point pen with the club logo, and a personalized membership card;
- An opportunity to attend the annual NHL Booster Club Convention and meet other NHL teams' Fan/Booster Club members in a different host city to celebrate friendship and ice hockey;
- A Fan Club lapel pin for each new adult member.

The Fan Club year runs from July 1 through June 30 annually, but you have until November 30 each year to renew your membership to ensure uninterrupted benefits of membership.

The Fan Club supports the Capitals at home and on the road. During the 2017-2018 season, we traveled to Boston, Philadelphia (bus), Las Vegas, Arizona, and Hershey twice. During 2018-2019 we travelled to Hershey and informally to New York, Detroit, and Hershey. You will usually find Fan Club members at most Caps road games whether it's an organized trip or fans traveling on their own to cheer for the Capitals.

Each year the Fan Club assists the Capitals when needed with Monumental Sports Foundation charity & community projects. We have also supported players' charities such as the Children's Hospital Foundation, So Kids Can, Make A Wish Foundation, and the American Special Hockey Association. Additionally, we've assisted local area youth hockey organizations such as the Nova Cool Cats and Fort Dupont Ice Arena Kids on Ice.
